Freedom of Information Request: 312021

Thank you for contacting CITB requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). Your email, dated 11th November 2021, asked for the following information:

The date range for the requests is from 2018 to present day. The data shall include a breakdown by year and by individual departments (e.g. separate departments, agencies, or public bodies within the main government agency), if applicable.

- 1. How many malicious emails have been successfully blocked?
- 2. What percentage of malicious emails were opened by staff?
- 3. What percentage of malicious links in the emails were clicked on by staff?
- 4. How many ransomware attacks were blocked by the department?
- 5. How many ransomware attacks were successful?

My response is as follows:

The data range to support this request is in fact 30 days from the date of the request, as O365 within CITB only retains the statistical data requested for a maximum of 30 days. The responses reflect this designated period:

- 2. Mails reported as phishing or potential phishing for further investigation: 65 (0.01%)
