## Freedom of Information Request: 172021

Thank you for contacting CITB requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). Your email, dated 2nd August 2021, asked for the following information:

I'm currently researching on the skills shortage within the crane industry:

- 1. Would you be able to inform me on the number of registered tower crane, crawler cranes, pedestrian crane and mobile crane ticket holders there are in the UK?
- 2. Would you also be able to let me know the amount of trained individuals needed to meet the demands for employment in these areas?

My response is as follows:

- We do not record the information you have requested in the specific way that you have requested. When you mention ticket holders, we assume you mean card holders for those vehicles. Crane based testing and awarding of plant-based cards is now carried out by CPCS (NOCN).
