Freedom of Information Request: 352021 response to Question 8

Thank you for contacting CITB requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). Your email, dated 29<sup>th</sup> November 2021, asked for the following information:

8. How many physical devices (IP's) do you have attached to your network that require monitoring for configuration vulnerabilities?

My response is as follows:

8. The information is dynamic. Depending on how many people are connected at a point in time.

So, as the question states "physical devices", we limit the scope to Printers, desktops and laptops. A Nessus scan is run every month against all network connected devices and the range is between 50 and 120 depending on how many people are in the offices.

If you are unhappy with this response, or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance.
